What can you do to get riddle answers? This depends on the type of riddle. Consider the following:

**Find The Key Element Of The Riddle**

Suppose your sock drawer has 6 black socks, 4 brown socks, 8 white socks, and 2 tan socks. How many socks do you need to pull out to be sure you have a pair of the same color?

With riddles like this, the fastest way to an answer is usually to find the "key element." Merely counting socks won't work.

**Watch For Misleading Clues**

Are you good at math? Complete the last two in this sequence: 1=3, 2=3, 3=5, 4=4, 5=4, 6=3, 7=?

Since a riddle usually tries to mislead, as soon as you read "Are you good at math?" you should be suspicious.

**Watch For The "Trick"**

The frog fell into a hole that was 14 1/2 feet deep. He could jump 3 feet, but he slid back a foot when he landed.

This riddle answer might appear to be 8 jumps, since the frog only makes 2 feet of progress each jump.

**Riddle Answers You Won't Get**

What English word is nine letters long, and can remain an English word at each step as you remove one letter at a time?

This is more like "word trivia" than a riddle. To find the answer, you would probably have to know a lot of words.

That one only makes it to six letters, but you get the point. Unfortunately, this doesn't give you a riddle answer.

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
