The master of your CD or DVD disk, is of the utmost importance for replication or duplication.

1. Always use the highest quality discs that you can obtain. Do your research, take your time.
2. Avoid copying from a network source if at all possible. If the source files for your disk burning software will create a temporary image file during the burning process. Once the burning is complete, the temporary image file will be deleted.
3. Avoid burning on a laptop computer that is low on battery power. The fluctuations that will occur may cause the burning process to fail.
4. Ensure that you finalise your disc. If you fail to finalise, the disc may not play back.
5. Never use the packet writing method to burn a master disc.
6. Avoid any type of impact or movement of the drive when burning. Movement can cause the laser to misalign and cause the burning process to fail.
7. Use the "burn-proof" feature if possible. This will allow the drive to slow down the burning process if it detects any errors.
8. Avoid having multiple applications open when burning. This can adversely affect your computer's performance.
