1. With the deadline for website accessibility is October 2004 when all points of the DDA become
2. The Disabled Rights Commission (DRC) is a government-funded body empowered by the Disability
3. The DRC conducted accessibility testing on over 1,000 UK public and private sector websites
4. One in seven people in the UK - about 8.5 million - suffer from some form of disability (Source: Royal National Institute of the Blind)
5. Two million people in the UK have a sight problem (Source: Royal National Institute of the Blind)
6. 8-10% of the male population has some sort of colour-blindness - for some reason it is more common in men
7. The world's first successful action over accessibility (Barry Maguire vs Sydney Olympics Organisers)
8. AOL settled out of court in an action brought by the US National Federation of the Blind but the settlement was for nothing
9. In February 2003 the Guardian newspaper slated Abbey National plc over its poor design and accessibility
10. Accessibility isn't just about serving groups of disabled users: the same standards also apply to everyone
